Exercice N°1 - Choisissez le temps qui convient (past simple ou past perfect) :

1. The wind **blew** / **had blown** away the magazines that I **leave** / **had left** on the garden table.
2. The teacher **corrected** / **had corrected** the essays that his students **wrote** / **had written**.
3. The girls **laughed** / **had laughed** at the pictures that they **took** / **had taken** the day before.

Exercice N°2 - Complétez les phrases suivantes avec le past simple ou le past perfect :

1. Yesterday, Wendy (go) **went** to Starbucks after work.
2. She (sit) **sat** down at a table outside and (look) **looked** at the menu.
3. When the waiter (come) **came** to take her order, she (be) **was** surprised.
4. It (be) **was** Simon, an old friend from school.
5. They (see/not) **had not seen** each other for at least ten years.
6. So they (tell) **told** each other what (happen) **had happened** in the past ten years.
